3 IMPORTANT NOTES TO ALL APPLICANTS

3.1. APPLICATION

- (a) All applicants must complete **ALL** the sections of the application form carefully and legibly and should submit this form to the SNR Assistant Registrar (Academic), P.O. Box MP 167, Mount Pleasant, Harare, Zimbabwe. Fill in your name and address on the attached card which will then be detached and returned to you as proof of receipt.
- (b) A non-refundable application fee of US\$50 for Zimbabweans and US\$70 for foreigners is payable before issuing a form.
- (c) Late applications may be considered but must be accompanied by a non-refundable late-application fee of US\$70.

3.2. DOCUMENTS TO ACCOMPANY APPLICATIONS

- (a) ALL applicants, *including those who are graduates of OR are currently studying at the University of Zimbabwe* must submit certificates of birth, marriage, and of qualifications gained at UZ **OR** at other universities.
- (b) Applicants must submit photocopies (not originals) of birth certificates and marriage certificates (in the case of married women), and documents verifying qualifications. If applicants have transcripts of their degree/diploma results, these are preferable to degree certificates. ALL COPIES OF TRANSCRIPTS AND CERTIFICATES MUST BE VERIFIED BY A COMMISSIONER OF OATHS OR HEAD OF THE INSTITUTE CONCERNED.
- * FAILURE TO SUBMIT ALL THE REQUESTED DOCUMENTS WILL RESULT IN THE RETURN OF THE APPLICATION FORM AND ENCLOSURES TO THE SENDER.

3.3. FINANCE

- (a) You must ensure that you have the necessary finance to pay fees on registration. You will not be allowed to register at the University unless you have paid your fees, or have produced evidence, to the satisfaction of the Bursar, of having the necessary sponsorship.
- (b) Part-time students are not eligible for University scholarships.
- (c) A limited number of University scholarships are available for Zimbabwean students. Normally, the criterion for an award is a first degree in the First or Upper Second Class. If you wish to apply for University sponsorship, please complete Section 6 on Page 5.

3.4. RESIDENCE (Postgraduate)

The number of places available in residence is very limited, priority will be given to undergraduates. Only postgraduates from outside the Harare area can be considered for residence and admission into residence can not be guaranteed. Applicants must plan for alternative accommodation.
