### **Key Tasks**

- To identify key characteristics of the UK Bribery Act 2010. The authors may choose 2 or 3 “innovations” of the UK Bribery Act which they find most relevant/applicable for the analysis of the selected countries.
- To review national anti-bribery legislation in three countries.
- To identify areas for legislative improvement in the three countries based upon the comparative analysis and lessons learned from the implementation of the legislation.
